Tips for praying for other women:

Pray for their ability to handle all the daily responsibilities.
5. **Pray for their children, grandchildren**: Important people in their lives.
6. **Pray for their husband** (if any): Marriages are so important to us. Pray for their relationship and interaction with their husband.
7. **Pray for their family**: extended families can have a big effect on us especially if there is turmoil. Pray for family members who need salvation.

8. **Pray for their friends:** Friends are important relationships that matter to us as women. Pray for friends who need salvation.
9. **Pray for their finances:** Everyone usually has some financial issues whether it is debt, upcoming bills, or sticking with a budget or how to spend money wisely or invest wisely.
10. **Pray for their choices:** everyone makes choices daily. Pray for good, godly, and wise choices.
11. **Pray for health:** we need to pray not just when they are sick, but thanksgiving when they are healthy and for continued health.
12. **Pray for their strength:** everyone is in need of strength and comfort, and encouragement whether we've just been through or going through hard times or not.
